CODE OF ETHICS



With high regard for the surveying profession a member of the Utah Council of Land Surveyors abides by the following Code of Ethics:

- 1. Acts for their clients and the public in an unbiased manner and accepts remuneration for professional services rendered
- 2. Exchanges information with other professional land surveyors and other related professions.
- 3. Brings credit, honor and dignity to the surveying profession.
- 4. Upholds the principle of appropriate and adequate compensation for professional land surveyors and those in their employ.
- 5. Avoids dissemination of false information which may harm another surveyor's professional reputation.
- 6. Solicits surveying work in a professional manner without undue influence.
- 7. Encourages contract negotiations and fee determination without prior knowledge of competitors' fees
- 8. Encourages other professional land surveyors to conform to ethical and professional practices.
- 9. Obeys all laws pertaining to the surveying profession.
- 10. Avoids interfering with another's existing surveyor-client agreement.
